The Northwest-Shoals Community College Academic and Vice President Councils met on Tuesday, March 4, 2014 in the Bevill Center – Room 148 on the Shoals campus.

1. Senior Day – Tom Carter

3. Project Updates – Joe Hackworth

- Building 104 will house the Plastic Injection Program. A new air conditioning has been installed, walls, floors, and ceiling have been painted, all electrical has been updated, and three new glass doors have been installed.
- Building 110 – Contracts for bids have been side and crews will soon start work in this building. Work is expected to be complete by this fall.
- Cosmetology Building – new building will be located by the Library on the Shoals Campus. Bids are due March 25th and once approved, work will start a week or two later. This building will be financed through some bond money. Construction is expected to last approximately 18 months.
- Two new HVAC systems will be purchased, one for each campus.
