## Section Transfers After the End of the Time for Changes in Registration

Students may be permitted to transfer from one section of a given class to another section of that same class, doing so under the following regulations:

- (1) Reasons for Transfers: Such transfers are generally permitted due to the need to change from day to night classes in view of job requirements, or the need to change campuses due to transportation problems created by the student having moved. However, the Dean of Instruction may authorize such transfers if investigation shows that the student has good reason for such. Preference for one instructor over another is not considered good cause, nor is the fact that a student is failing as sound basis for such a transfer.
- (2) Regulations Governing Transfer: The instructor receiving the student by transfer must agree to the arrangement. Although the previous instructor's approval is not required, this instructor will be notified on such transfer, and all grades assigned previous to the transfer must be used by the receiving instructor in determining the students final grade. Such grades must be supplied to the Dean of Instruction. The Dean will transmit these to the receiving instructor.
